# **FACTS**

# Last match: (6 Sep 2019):

United States 0-3 Mexico (Javier Hernández, Erick Gutiérrez and Uriel Antuna), International Friendly match at MetLife Stadium (East Rutherford, NJ, USA).

### Last match in a final (7 Jul 2019):

Mexico 1-0 United States with a goal by Jonathan Dos Santos (assisted by Raúl Jiménez) in the 2019 Concacaf Gold Cup, Soldier Field in Chicago, USA.

#### **Knockout matches:**

11 games, with 7 victories for Mexico, 3 for the United States and 1 draw, where the United States advanced on penalties.

1991 Gold Cup (Semifinal): USA 2-0 MEX. The United States advances.

1993 Gold Cup (Final): MEX 4-0 USA. Mexico champion.

Copa América 1995 (Quarterfinals): USA 0-0 (4-1) MEX. The United States advances in the penalty shootout.

1998 Gold Cup (Final): USA 0-1 MEX. Mexico champion.

1999 FIFA Confederations Cup (Semifinal): MEX 1-0 USA. Mexico advances.

2002 FIFA World Cup Korea / Japan (Round of 16): MEX 0-2 USA. The United States advances.

Gold Cup 2007 (Final): USA 2-1 MEX. United States champion.

Gold Cup 2009 (Final): USA 0-5 MEX Mexico champion.

Gold Cup 2011 (Final): USA 2-4 MEX. Mexico champion.

CONCACAF Cup 2015 (Final): USA 2-3 MEX. Mexico qualifies for the 2017 FIFA Confederations Cup.

Gold Cup 2019 (Final): MEX 1-0 USA. Mexico champion.

#### Definitions in overtime and penalty kicks:

Copa América Uruguay 1995 (Quarterfinals): USA 0-0 (4-1) MEX. The United States advanced after winning on penalties (goals from Eric Wynalda, Joe-Max Moore, Paul Caligiuri and Frank Klopas; Luis García Postigo). (Jul 17, 1995), in the Artigas de Paysandú

Park, URU.

1999 FIFA Confederations Cup (Semifinal): MEX 1-0 USA. Mexico advanced in Extra Time thanks to a goal by Cuauhtémoc Blanco at minute 97 (1 Aug 1999), at Estadio Azteca, MEX.

CONCACAF Cup 2015 (Final): USA 2-3 MEX (Geoff Cameron 15 'and Bobby Wood 108'; Javier Hernández 10 ', Oribe Peralta 96' and Paul Aguilar 118 '), in the Playoffs for the 2017 Confederations Cup. Mexico advanced in Extra Time after drawing 1-1 in regulation time at the Rose Bowl in Pasadena, USA (10 Oct 2015).

2019 (Final): MEX 1-0 USA, goal by Jonathan Dos Santos, at Soldier Field (Chicago, IL, USA). (7-Jul-2019).

**Top scorers in finals**: Andrés Guardado (MEX) to USA in 2007, USA in 2011 and Jamaica in 2015 (3 goals). Landon Donovan (USA) to MEX in 2007 and 2011; Giovani Dos Santos

(MEX) to the USA in 2009 and 2011; and **Pablo Barrera (MEX)** to USA in 2011, being the only player to score a brace in a Gold Cup final (2 goals).

**Landon Donovan** is the top scorer for the United States vs. Mexico: 2 goals (in the 2007 and 2011 editions).

**Eric Wynalda** is the USA's soccer player with the most games against Mexico: 3 (1991, 1993 and 1998).

**Robert Bradley** (USA) is the coach of the United States who led the most games against Mexico: 3 (2007, 2009 and 2011). Also, Bora Milutinovic (1991 and 1993), Steve Sampson (1998) and Gregg Berhalter (2019).

**Benny Feilhaber** is the youngest American scorer against Mexico at 22 years, 5 months and 5 days. Meanwhile, Landon Donovan is the oldest scorer at 29 years, 3 months and 21 days.

**Michael Bradley** scored the fastest goal for the United States against Mexico in the Gold Cup: at 7 minutes, 15 seconds, in a 2-4 loss in the 2011 Final (25-Jun-2011).

**Giovani Dos Santos**, Pablo Barrera and Andrés Guardado are Mexico's top scorers against the United States in the Gold Cup with 2 scores each.

**Andrés Guardado** is the Mexican player with the most matches against the United States in the Gold Cup: 3 (2007, 2011 and 2019).

**Manuel Lapuente (MEX)** is the coach who faced-off the United States the most times as coach of Mexico (1991 and 1998 editions). In addition, Miguel Mejía (1993), Hugo Sánchez (2007), Javier Aguirre (2009), José Manuel De La Torre (2011) and Gerardo Martino (2019).

**Giovani Dos Santos** is the youngest Mexican scorer in matches against the USA at 20 years, 2 months and 15 days. Meanwhile, Guillermo Franco is the oldest scorer with 32 years, 8 months and 23 days (both scored their goals in Final matches.

**Ignacio Ambriz** scored the fastest goal for Mexico against the United States in the CONCACAF Gold Cup: at 12 minutes, in a 4-0 victory in the 1993 Final (25-Jul-1993).



The United States is the second highest winner in CONCACAF Gold Cup history. It played 11 finals and was 6-time champion: 1991 (vs. HON), 2002 (vs. CRC), 2005 (vs. PAN), 2007 (vs. MEX), 2013 (vs. PAN) and 2017 (vs. JAM). In addition, he obtained 5 times the Runner-up where he always faced Mexico (1993, 1998, 2009, 2011 and 2019) and 3 times the 3rd place (1996, 2003 and 2015).

It has 16 appearances Gold Cup (includes 2021). Gold Cup record: 79 GP: 61W-9D-9L (162GF-55GA).

Landon Donovan is the top scorer for USA and in Gold Cup history with 18 goals.

In addition, he is the player with the most participation in the Gold Cup (34 matches). They are followed by Clint Dempsey (13 goals) and Eric Wynalda (9).

**Bruce Arena (USA)** is the coach with the most matches managed for the United States in Gold Cup, in 2000, 2002, 2003, 2005 and 2017 (24): 19W-4L-1D

2019/20 CNL RECORD: G-5 W-4 D-0 L-1 (GF-16 GC-3) +13

**DT: Gregg Berhalter (USA)**: G-27 W-18 D-3 L-6 (7.4% efficiency). USA lost two games under he's manages vs. Mexico: (0-1 Gold Cup Final 2019 and 0-3 International Friendly 2019).

As a player, he faced-off Mexico in the 1999 Confederations Cup (1-0 defeat in Overtime), the 2000 International Friendly (3-0 victory), the 2002 FIFA World Cup Korea and Japan (0-2 victory) and the CONCACAF FIFA World Qualifiers 2006 (defeat 2-1 and triumph 2-0).

Gregg Berhalter's Gold Cup record: G-6 W-5 D-0 L-1.

**Results**: United States 4-0 Guyana, United States 6-0 Trinidad & amp; Tobago, Panama 0-1 United States, United States 1-0 Curação, Jamaica 1-3 United States and Mexico 1-0 United States.

#### Results in CNL 2019/20:

Group A: 7-0 to Cuba (Weston McKennie x3, Jordan Morris, Darío Ramos e / c, Joshua Sargent and Christian Pulisic), defeat 2-0 vs. Canada (Alphonso Davies and Lucas Cavallini), 4-1 to Canada (Jordan Morris, Gyasi Zardes x2 and Aaron Long; Steven Vitoria) and 0-4 to Cuba (Joshua Sargent x2 and Jordan Morris x2). Semifinal: 0-1 to Honduras (Theoson-Jordan Siebatcheu).

**Top Scorers in CNL 2019/20**: Jordan Morris (4), Josh Sargent and Weston McKennie (3). Jordan Morris is the player with the highest goal participation in CNL 2019/20 (4 goals and 4 assists).

2019/20 CNL Assists Leader: Jordan Morris (4) and Weston McKennie (3).

**Total saves in CNL 2019/20**: 12. Goalkeepers: Brad Guzan (4) and Zack Steffen (8). Weston McKennie and Joshua Sargent were the US footballers with the most scoring situations in CNL (11 shots).

**Josh Sargent, Weston Mckennie and Gio Reyna** were the players with the most scoring chances in the semi-finals against Honduras (2 shots each).

Zack Steffen made 4 saves against Honduras.

**Weston McKennie** is the American player with the most minutes played in the Nations League (398 '). They are followed by Tim Ream (373 ') and Jackson Yueill (361').

**Christian Pulisic** faced-off Mexico 4 times in his professional career and could never win: 1 draw and 3 losses (CONCACAF World Cup Qualifiers 2018, Gold Cup 2019 and International Friendly).



# **MEXICO**

Mexico is the highest winner in the history of the Gold Cup. He played 9 finals and was 8 times Champion: 1993 (vs. USA), 1996 (vs. BRA), 1998 (vs. USA), 2003 (vs. BRA), 2009 (vs. USA), 2011 (vs. USA), 2015 (vs. JAM) and 2019 (vs. USA). In addition, he won the Runner-up once (2007) and 3 times the 3rd place (1991, 2013 and 2017).

**It has 16 appearances in the Gold Cup** (includes 2021). Gold Cup record: 73 GP: 53W-11D-9L (171GF-45GA). He is the top scorer in the history of the continental tournament: 171 (2.34 average per game).

**Luis Alves "Zague" and Andrés Guardado**, with 12 goals, are Mexico's top scorers in the history of the Gold Cup. With 7 goals, they are followed by Jared Borgetti, Javier Hernández and Raúl Jiménez.

**Andrés Guardado** is the Mexican with the most participation in the Gold Cup (24 games) and the top scorer in finals (3). Currently, he leads globally the table of goals (12) and assists (8) in the history of the tournament.

**Manuel Lapuente (MEX)** is the coach with the most matches with Mexico in the Gold Cup in the 1991, 1998 and 2000 editions (12 Games: 8W-2D-2L /

2019/20 CNL RECORD: G-5 W-4 D-1 L-0 (GF-13 GA-3) +10

**Head Coach: Gerardo Martino (ARG)**: G-26 W-21 D-3 L-2. He was champion of the CONCACAF Gold Cup in 2019. He has two victories in the last 2 matches (0-1 Gold Cup Final 2019 and 0-3 Friendly 2019 International). In addition, he added victories against the USA with the Paraguay National Team (1-3 in the 2007 Copa América and 0-1 in the 2011 International Friendly) and with the Argentina team (0-4 in the 2016 Copa América Centenario).

**Gerardo Martino's record in the Gold Cup**: G-6 W-5 D-1 L-0. Results: Mexico 7-0 Cuba, Mexico 3-1 Canada, Martinique 2-3 Mexico, Mexico 1-1 (5-4) Costa Rica, Mexico 1-0 Haiti (Overtime) and Mexico 1-0 United States. \* NOTE: the game Mexico vs. Haiti in the 2019 Gold Cup Semifinals was directed on the field by Jorge Theiler, assistant to "Tata", due to Martino's suspension for yellow cards.

#### Results in CNL 2019/20:

Group B: 1-5 to Bermudas (Nahki Wells; Uriel Antuna, José Macías x2, Hirving Lozano and Héctor Herrera), 3-1 to Panama (Roberto Alvarado, José Macías and Rodolfo Pizarro; Carlos Salcedo e / c), 0- 3 to Panama (Raúl Jiménez x2, Édson Álvarez) and 2-1 to Bermuda (Sebastián Córdova and Uriel Antuna; Dante Leverock). Semifinal: 0-0 (victory 5-4 in penalty shootout) vs. Costa Rica.

Top Scorers in CNL 2019/20: José Juan Macías (3), Uriel Antuna and Raúl Jiménez (2).

Assists leader in CNL 2019/20: Roberto Alvarado (2).

**Total saves in CNL 2019/20: 10**. Goalkeepers: Guillermo Ochoa (4), Raúl Gudiño (3), Rodolfo Cota (2) and Hugo González (1). Guillermo Ochoa saved the penalty against Costa Rica.

**Uriel Antuna (332 '), Héctor Moreno and Edson Álvarez (303')** are the Mexican players with the most minutes played in the CONCACAF Nations League.

**Uriel Antuna and José Juan Macías** were the Mexican players with the most goal situations in the current 2019/20 CONCACAF Nations League (10 and 9 shots respectively).

Hirving Lozano and Héctor Herrera were the players with the most shots in the 2019/20 CNL Semifinals against Costa Rica (3 each). The forward faced USA 3 times and never lost (2W-1D): 1-2 and 1-1 in CONCACAF Qualifiers Russia 2018 and 0-3 (Friendly). Hector Herrera played 5 times against the USA with a balance of 3 wins, 1 draw and 1 loss (CONCACAF Qualifiers, FIFA Confederations Cup and International Friendly).

**Andrés Guarded played 12 times against the United States** (2 goals in the Gold Cup finals: 2007 and 2011). He added 6 wins, 2 draws and 4 losses. In addition to the Gold Cup, he faced the national team of the stars and stripes in International Friendlies, CONCACAF World Cup qualifiers and FIFA Confederations Cup.
