



Mount Pleasant FA (JAM) vs. Real Hope FA (HAI)

Sabina Park Stadium, Kingston, JAM, Group A

They will face each other for the first time in the Concacaf Caribbean Cup and in their history.



MOUNT PLEASANT (JAM)

Police FC (TTO) 0x0 Mount Pleasant (JAM)

It's the 2nd consecutive game without a loss for Mount Pleasant in the tournament's history (1W-1D).

Mount Pleasant's record in the current edition of the tournament includes 1 win (against Arnett Gardens 1x2), 1 draw (against Police FC 0x0), and 1 loss (against Cavalier SC 0x2).

It is the 12th 0x0 draw for clubs from Jamaica in the history of the tournament; in fact, it's the 3rd time it's been achieved against clubs from Trinidad & Tobago:

- Portmore United (JAM) against W Connection (TTO), November 26, 2003
- Harbour View (JAM) against San Juan Jabloteh (TO), November 14, 2007
- Mount Pleasant (JAM) against Police FC (TTO), September 26, 2024

It's the 9th 0x0 draw for clubs from Trinidad & Tobago in the history of the tournament. In fact, a Trinidadian club had not drawn a match without goals in the competition since May 22, 2015, when Central FC drew 0x0 against Don Bosco (HAI).

The last time a club from Trinidad & Tobago drew 0x0 in the group stage was on April 30, 2013, when W Connection drew without goals against Antigua Barracuda (ATG), on Matchday 3 of Group 1 in their first round.

Mount Pleasant Football Academy will complete its participation in the group stage of the 2024 Caribbean Cup. The runner-up of the 2023/24 Jamaican National Premier League achieved all three possible results in their 3 appearances (1 win, 1 draw, and 1 loss).

Mt. Pleasant will seek their second victory in the tournament after defeating Arnett Gardens in Round 2 of Group A of the 2024 CCC: 2-1 (Shai Smith; Jahshaun Anglin and Kimoni Bailey), at Sabina Park Stadium, Kingston.

Along with their compatriots Arnett Gardens, they are the clubs with the fewest goals in the current competition (2). They scored from open play and a header in the last 15 minutes of each half. Their 3 goals conceded in their first appearance in the CONCACAF Caribbean Cup came from set pieces, with 2 goals from headers and 1 from a penalty.

Players to watch:

Jahshaun Anglin (JAM). Scored the first goal for Mt. Pleasant in the history of the competition with a header. He led the overall list for total passes (189) on his current team and was the player with the most shots in Round 4 (5). He ranks second in shots (10).

Daniel Green (JAM). Made the most shots in the first 3 matches for Mt. Pleasant (11) in the 2024 CONCACAF Caribbean Cup. The 27-year-old forward provided 1 assist against Arnett Gardens.

Shaquan Davis (JAM). Kept a clean sheet against Miscellaneous Police FC thanks to his 3 saves and 1 clearance. The goalkeeper completed 89% of his passes in the last match of the 2024 Caribbean Cup.



REAL HOPE (HAI)

Real Hope (HAI) 0x0 Arnett Gardens (JAM)

It's the 3rd consecutive game without a defeat for Real Hope in the competition (2D-1W), in fact, it's their best streak of consecutive games without a loss in the tournament's history.

It's the 1st 0x0 draw for Real Hope in the competition, and it's the 2nd draw in 9 games played for the Haitian club in the tournament (5L-2W-2D).

It's the 2nd consecutive game without a defeat for Real Hope against Jamaican clubs in the competition; in fact, it's the 1st draw against these clubs so far in the competition.

It's the 2nd game without a win at home for Real Hope against Jamaican clubs in the competition, however, with the draw, they managed not to lose, as in their 1st home encounter against Jamaican clubs, Real Hope lost 0x2 to Waterhouse on May 14, 2019, when Keithy Simpson and Stephen Williams scored for the Jamaicans.

Real Hope FA will complete its participation in the group stage of the Caribbean Cup. They maintain an undefeated record in their first participation in the tournament (1W-2D): 1-1 vs. Miscellaneous Police FC (Angelo Exilus; Kwesi Allen), 2-1 vs. Cavalier (Dwayne Atkinson; Rikanel Chery and Steeve Mondestin) and 0-0 vs. Arnett Gardens in Group A.

The club from the city of Cap-Haïtien kept a clean sheet in their last match of the tournament (0-0 vs. Arnett Gardens). At the same time, it maintains the least breached defense in the current competition: they conceded 2 goals (during the first and final 5 minutes).

The Haitian team scored 3 goals in their 2 appearances in the tournament. They did not score any goals during the first 30 minutes of play. They also did not celebrate any header goals in the competition, being the team that took the least corner kicks in the tournament (7).

Players to watch:

Daniel Saint-Fleur (HAI). The 24-year-old midfielder ranks first in total passes (254). He was the player with the most accurate passes (64) in the last match of the tournament.

Huguens Michel (HAI). Leads the rankings in shots (5) and fouls received (7) for Real Hope in the tournament. He completed 292 minutes in the 2024 Caribbean Cup and achieved a passing accuracy of 88%.

Steeve Mondestin (HAI). He scored the penalty goal that gave Real Hope their first and only victory in the history of the competition (2-1 vs. Cavalier). He led the list of shots (2) in the 0-0 against Arnett Gardens in Round 4.
