Police FC (TRI) vs. Mount Pleasant FA (JAM)

They will face each other for the first time in the Concacaf Caribbean Cup and in their history.



POLICE FC (TRI)

Miscellaneous Police FC will play at home for the second time in their debut tournament at the Concacaf Caribbean Cup; in their first home game, they defeated Arnett Gardens 2-1 (Joevin Jones and Ezekiel Kesar; Warner Brown) on September 19, 2024, at Hasely Crawford Stadium, Port of Spain.

In their previous 3 matches, they managed to surpass their opponents in ball possession (52% vs. Real Hope FA, 56% vs. Cavalier, and 55% vs. Arnett Gardens). They completed 943 effective passes (84.6% accuracy).

The club, based in the city of Saint James, will seek their second consecutive victory in the CCC. 50% of their goals were scored via headers. Kwesi Allen (vs. Real Hope FA) and Kevon Woodley (vs. Cavalier).

Record in the CCC: Played-3, Wins-1, Draws-1, Losses-1 (Goals For-4, Goals Against-6).

Players to watch:

Joevin Jones (TRI). He contributed a goal and was the player with the most shots (3) in the sole victory of Miscellaneous Police FC in the competition (2-1 vs. Arnett Gardens). The midfielder has 10 matches in the history of the CCC.

Jabari Mitchell (TRI). He was one of the key players in the 2-1 victory against Arnett Gardens in the last match. There, the midfielder contributed 1 shot on goal, 3 recovered balls, and an 88% pass accuracy (33 total).

Kevon Woodley (TRI). Led the list of shots (9) in previous tournament matches. He scored the goal against Cavalier in Group A. The 38-year-old forward made 9 of the 31 shots by the Trinidadian team in the Caribbean Cup 2024.



MT. PLEASANT (JAM)

Mount Pleasant Football Academy, runners-up of the Jamaica National Premier League 2023/24, secured 50% of the points in two matches (1 Win-1 Loss).

They will have their second away match after defeating Arnett Gardens (Shai Smith; Jahshaun Anglin and Kimoni Bailey) at Sabina Park Stadium, Kingston.

The 3 goals conceded in the two matches came from set plays, including two headers and one penalty.

Players to watch:

Jahshaun Anglin (JAM). He scored the first goal for Mt. Pleasant in the history of the CCC with a header, opening the scoring and leading the team in shots (3) against Arnett Gardens in Round 2. He topped the overall accurate passes list (107) in Round 1.

Daniel Green (JAM). He made the most shots (7) in Mt. Pleasant's first two matches of the CCC. The 27-year-old forward delivered 1 assist in the last match against Arnett Gardens.

Shaquille Dyer (JAM). He was one of the key players in the victory over Arnett Gardens. The defender contributed with 18 successful passes, 2 recoveries, and 1 clearance. In his 2 appearances in the tournament, he achieved a 93% pass accuracy.
