

## Grenades FC (ATG) vs. Moca (DOM)

Moca Stadium 85, Group B

They will face each other for the first time in the Concacaf Caribbean Cup and in their history.



Ouanaminthe FC (HAI) 2x2 Grenades FC (ATG)

5th consecutive game without a win for Grenades FC (3D-2D), marking the first time in tournament history they have accumulated two consecutive draws.

4th away game without a victory for Grenades FC (3L-1D), in fact, the Antiguan club recorded three consecutive draws away from home for the first time in the competition.

2nd time Grenades FC has drawn 2-2 away in the competition, having previously drawn with the same score against Cibao FC (DOM) on May 16, 2017. On that occasion, Woodensky Cherenfant scored twice for Cibao FC, while Tevuaghn Harriette and César García (AG) scored for Grenades FC.

Grenades FC has scored 14 goals in the history of the competition.

Quinton Griffith (ATG) of Grenades FC reached two goals in tournament history, his last goal dating back to May 6, 2012, when playing for Antigua Barracuda he scored against Inter Moengotapoe (SUR).

Malcolm Stewart (VIN) of Grenades FC scored his first goal in tournament history.

Grenades FC will have played 4 matches in the CONCACAF Caribbean Cup. They will complete their participation in the current competition and seek their first victory in the tournament. They collected their first 2 points in the last 2 matchdays. The Antigua & Barbuda team drew 1-1 against AC Port of Spain in Port of Spain and 2-2 vs. Ouanaminthe in Moca. They have not won in the competition yet, having lost their debut against Cibao FC: 1-2 (Sherman Augustin; Jean López and Edippo Rodríguez) in Santiago de los Caballeros.

They scored 4 goals in the current tournament, 3 in the second halves. They celebrated 50% of their goals with headers in their first participation in the CONCACAF tournament. They are the team with the most saves in the competition (18).

The champion of the Antigua and Barbuda First Division 2022/23 won 4 of their last 8 matches in CONCACAF competitions. Their last victory in an international competition was against Dublanc (Sherman Augustin) in the semifinals of the Caribbean Club Shield 2024.

## Players to Watch:

**Quinton Griffith (ATG)**. Leads the list of passes (145) in the Antigua & Barbuda team. The captain contributed his goal share in the last game against Ouanaminthe in the 2-2 draw in Moca 85 and provided 30 accurate passes.

**Zaieem Scott (ATG)**. Is the goalkeeper with the best save record (18) in the CONCACAF Caribbean Cup 2024 (5 goals conceded). The experienced goalkeeper accumulated 292 minutes in the tournament and made 8 clearances.

**Malcolm Stewart (VIN)**. Leads the category of shots (8) for Grenades FC in the current competition. He was involved in 50% of the team's goals in the tournament (1 goal vs. Ouanaminthe and 1 assist vs. Cibao FC). The forward was the team's top scorer (3) in the Caribbean Club Shield 2024.



Moca Football Club will have played 12 matches in the CONCACAF Caribbean Cup after its second appearance (2023 and 2024) in the competition. The team, led by Hiram Apaiz (MEX), remains undefeated in the current edition (2W-1D) and has secured its participation in the

2024 semifinals. Coming off two consecutive wins (3-2 vs. AC Port of Spain and 3-1 vs. Ouanaminthe), it aims for the top spot in Group B.

Moca FC kept a clean sheet in 5 of its previous 11 matches. The Dominican team has gone 5 games without a loss (3W-2D) in the history of the competition. It has won 2 of its last 4 away games (2-0 vs. Defence Force and 2-1 vs. Harbour View in 2023).

Of its last 10 goals, 50% were scored from set plays (2 headers and 3 penalties). It was the team that scored the most headers in the first edition of the CONCACAF Caribbean Cup: 3 (Manuel Vidal, Gustavo Ascona, and José Francisco). However, it has not yet scored in this manner in the current competition.

Best result in the CCC: 3rd place (2023).

## Players to watch:

**Gustavo Ascona (ARG)**. He is the club's top scorer in the history of the competition (6 goals in 11 appearances). He scored 3 from open play, 2 from penalties, and 1 from a header. He was involved in 2 of the last 3 goals (1 goal and 1 assist) and is the player with the most shots in the current squad (8).

**Clifford Thomas (HAI)**. He leads the team in passes (131) and ball recoveries (7) in Moca FC in the 2024 Caribbean Cup. He scored the winning goal to defeat AC Port of Spain 3-2 in Round 2 of Group B of the current tournament.

**Miguel Báez (DOM)**. The captain made 6 saves and 5 clearances in the 3-1 victory over Ouanaminthe in his last appearance in Group B. The goalkeeper has accumulated 38 saves and 5 clean sheets in the history of the competition."
