



#54 CD Águila (SLV) vs. FC Motagua (HON)

Estadio Cuscatlán, San Salvador, SLV

CD Águila will seek to overturn the 0-2 deficit from the first leg at the Chelato Uclés Stadium in Tegucigalpa, Honduras. For FC Motagua, Luis Vega and Agustín Auzmendi scored on October 22, 2024. With this goal, Auzmendi reached 10 goals in the CCAC.



CD Águila (SLV)

Club Deportivo Águila won 3 of their last 6 matches in the CCAC. The Salvadoran team is undefeated at home with two wins and one draw.

CD Águila has made 14 appearances in the Concacaf Champions Cup, the most recent in 2012-13 (1962, 1964, 1965, 1969, 1973, 1976, 1977, 1980, 1985, 1987, 1988, 1993, 1994, 2012/13).

CD Águila has achieved 4 clean sheets in 7 matches in the 2024 edition: (0-0 vs. Antigua GFC, 2-0 vs. Olimpia, 0-3 vs. CAI in Group C, and 0-0 vs. Real Estelí in the quarterfinals). The Salvadoran team leads the 2024 edition in recoveries with (121). Out of their last 7 goals, 6 were scored in the second half.

Participation in the CCAC: 2 (2023 and 2024).

Best result: Quarterfinals 2024.

Players to follow:

Darwin Cerén (SLV). He has been a vacuum in midfield with 17 recoveries in the 2024 edition, along with delivering 411 passes and making 15 shots. In the first leg in Tegucigalpa, he made 124 passes.

Blas Sosa (ARG). He scored in 2 of Águila's last 4 CCAC matches. Sosa is the only player on the current roster who scored in both the group stage and the knockout stage (against CAI in Group C and Real Estelí in the quarterfinals).

Santos Ortiz (SLV). He has (5) assists in the 2024 edition and is the player with the most fouls suffered (17). He has played in 16 matches in Concacaf club tournaments.



FC Motagua (HON)

Fútbol Club Motagua won 3 of their last 12 matches in the CCAC.

In the 2023 Play-In, they were eliminated by Deportivo Saprissa with an aggregate score of 6-2 (they drew 2-2 in Tegucigalpa).

FC Motagua has 18 appearances in the Concacaf Champions Cup (1969, 1971, 1974, 1983, 1986, 1991, 1992, 1993, 1995, 2003, 2008, 2010/11, 2011/12, 2015/16, 2018, 2020, 2022, 2023).

All four of FC Motagua's losses in the CCAC were away games. The Honduran team drew with different scores in 3 of their last 4 matches: Herediano (1-1 in Group A, 2-2 and 0-0 in the quarterfinals). In the 2024 edition, the Honduran side has the best shooting efficiency percentage (18.8%).

Participation in the CCAC: 2 (2023 and 2024).

Best result in the CCAC: Quarterfinals 2023 and 2024 (Played the Play-In in both editions).

Players to follow:

Agustín Auzmendi (ARG). He is the top scorer in the CCAC with 10 goals in 15 matches. He is also the leading scorer in the Play-In with 3 goals (2 against Saprissa and 1 against CD Águila). In the 2-0 victory in the first leg, he scored a goal and took 5 shots.

Román Rubilio Castillo (HON). The team captain leads in shots (14) and goals (3) in the 2024 edition. The forward has scored 8 goals in 22 appearances in Concacaf club tournaments.

Jorge Serrano (PAN). He provided an assist in the 2-0 win over CD Águila. The Panamanian, along with Argentine midfielder Rodrigo Gómez, has 4 assists in the CCAC. In the 2024 edition, he has delivered 197 passes.
