

Cibao FC (DOM) vs. Ouanaminthe (HAI)

Cibao, Santiago de los Caballeros, Group B

They will face each other for the first time in the Concacaf Caribbean Cup and in their history.



Port of Spain (TRI) 2x3 Cibao FC (DOM)

Jean Carlos López (DOM) from Cibao FC has reached 3 goals in the history of the competition, and this is the first edition of a Caribbean club tournament where the Dominican player scores more than one goal, since in 2018 he only scored against W Connection (TRI) on February 4, 2018.

Rivaldo Correa (COL) from Cibao FC scored his first double in the history of the tournament, and he is the third Colombian to score for the Dominican club in the history of the tournament, after Juan David Díaz and Dairin González, both on May 17, 2022. Additionally, he is the first Colombian player to score a double for his club in the competition.

Cibao FC has reached 39 goals scored in the history of the competition.

It's the fourth consecutive match without defeat for Cibao FC in the tournament (3W-1D), in fact, the team has recorded two consecutive victories for the third time in its history.

It's the second consecutive away victory for Cibao FC in the competition, indeed, it is the first time in the history of the tournament that the Dominican club has accumulated two consecutive away wins.

It's the third consecutive victory in as many matches for Cibao FC against clubs from Trinidad & Tobago, having won 1-0 against Central FC on May 18, 2017, and 1-0 against San Juan Jabloteh in the Grand Final of 2017 on May 21, 2017.

It's the ninth victory for Cibao FC in the competition in 19 matches played.

Cibao Football Club will have played 8 matches in the CONCACAF Caribbean Cup following its second appearance in the history of the competition (editions 2023 and 2024). The team from

Santiago de los Caballeros will complete its participation in the group stage of 2024. It will aim for the top spot in the Group B standings after securing its participation in the semifinals.

The team coached by Scheldeur Sainvilus (HAI) remains undefeated in the current tournament (0-0 vs. Moca FC, 2-1 vs. Grenades FC, and 3-2 vs. AC Port of Spain in Group B). Coincidentally, the Dominican team secured its two victories in this tournament playing as the visiting team. However, its only clean sheet was achieved at home (0-0 vs. Moca).

Cibao FC has three victories in its previous seven games in the Caribbean Cup, all in the group stage (2023 and 2024): 2-1 vs. Harbour View (Yohan Parra and Carlos Heredia; Shaqueil Bradford) in 2023, 2-1 (Sherman Augustin; Jean López and Edipo Rodríguez) and 3-2 vs. AC Port of Spain (Shackiel Smek Henry and Jameel Neptune; Jean López and Rivaldo Correa x2) in 2024.

Participations in the Concacaf Caribbean Cup: 2 (2023 and 2024).

Best result in the CCC: semifinals (2024).

Record in the CCC: GP-7 W-3 D-2 L-2 (GF-9 GA-8).

Players to watch:

Herold Charles (HAI). Entered as a substitute in the 53rd minute of the last match to change the game and provide 3 assists to fuel Cibao's comeback and secure a 3-2 victory over AC Port of Spain.

Rivaldo Correa (COL). Celebrated twice to turn the score around in the last match against AC Port of Spain, earning a ticket to the semifinals of the tournament. The Colombian has taken 10 shots in the 2024 CONCACAF tournament.

Jean López (DOM). Scored 2 goals in the current edition and is the top player in passes (133) in the Dominican Republic squad (contributed his share in the victories against Grenades FC and AC Port of Spain). Completed 92% of his passes in the tournament.



Ouanaminthe FC will play their fourth match and bid farewell to the 2024 CONCACAF Caribbean Cup. Led by Joseph Roudy (HAI), they will seek their first victory in the history of the competition. They earned 2 points out of 9 available (1-1 against AC Port of Spain in Round 1 and 2-2 versus Grenades FC in Round 4). Their only loss came against Moca with a score of 3-1 (Round 3).

The Haitian club averaged 17 shots per game in the current competition. They scored 4 goals, took 21 shots on goal, had 25 shots off target, and hit the post once. They achieved a shooting accuracy of 7.8%. They both scored and conceded goals in each of their matches in the tournament.

They did not score in the initial and final 15 minutes of any match in the CONCACAF Caribbean Cup. They recorded 2 penalty goals, 1 header, and 1 from open play (they conceded an average of 2 goals per game).

Players to watch:

Joseph Willinx (HAI). He is the team's top scorer in the current competition (3) and the top player in shots (10). The forward has the second-highest passing accuracy percentage (85%) among the Haitian squad.

James Cene (HAI). The 18-year-old midfielder leads the total passes list (180) for Ouanaminthe. He completed 147 accurate passes and contributed 14 ball recoveries in the group stage.

Widjoly Minoche (HAI). He has the most ball recoveries (17) and fouls received (7) in the tournament. The 19-year-old player provided 76 accurate passes in the current competition with an accuracy of 84%. He totaled 8 shots in the Caribbean Cup.
