

## New England Revolution (USA) vs. Club America (MEX)

Tuesday April 2, 2024, Gillette Stadium, Foxborough (USA)

They will face each other for the first time in the CCC.

New England Revolution will play in the CCC quarterfinals for the third time; in previous participations, they were eliminated by Alajuela (CRC) in 2002-2003 and 2005-2006, Joe Public (TRI) in 2008-2009, and against Pumas UNAM (MEX) in 2022.

For the New England Revolution, it will be the second time they face a Liga MX rival in the CCC. In 2022, they faced Pumas UNAM in the quarterfinals, where they were eliminated. They won 3-0 in the first leg with goals from Sebastián Lletget, Adam Buksa (x2), and lost 0-3 in the second leg at Ciudad Universitaria, with goals from Pumas' Juan Ignacio Dinenno (x2) and Sebastián Saucedo. In the penalty shootout, Pumas won 4-3.

CF América has three consecutive victories and has not lost in their last four matches against MLS clubs (W-3 D-1). Club América has won three of the last four series against MLS rivals. The last time they were eliminated was in 2020 by Los Angeles FC, which was played as a single match due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Club América won the series against Seattle Sounders in 2016, Atlanta United in 2020, and Portland Timbers in 2021. The top scorers against MLS rivals are Carlos Darwin Quintero (COL), Oribe Peralta (MEX), Leo Suárez (ARG), Henry Martin (MEX), and Federico Viñas (URU), all with two goals.



New England Revolution eliminated LD Alajuelense (5-1) on aggregate (4-0 and 1-1).

New England Revolution remains undefeated in the 2024 CCC and is the second team with the most points (3-W-1D). They defeated CAI in Round One (0-1 and 3-0) and LD Alajuelense in the round of 16 (4-0 and 1-1).

New England Revolution finished as the leader in balls recovered with (72) in the first two phases of the 2024 CCC. Matt Polster, Nick Lima, and Andrew Farrell were the players with the most ball recoveries with (7).



Playing at home, they have three consecutive victories without conceding goals in the first 30 minutes: 3-0 vs. Pumas UNAM (Quarterfinals 2022), 3-0 vs. Club Atlético Independiente (Round One 2024), and 4-0 vs. Alajuelense (Round of 16 2024). They haven't lost at home since they were defeated (4-0) against Joe Public from Trinidad and Tobago in the Play-off in 2008/09.

**Semi-final qualifications**: They have never qualified for the semifinals. They were eliminated twice in the quarterfinals in the 2006 edition by Alajuelense (global score of 1-0) and in 2022 by Pumas UNAM (lost on penalties after drawing 3-3 on aggregate).

## Players to watch:

**Tomás Chancalay (ARG).** Has scored three goals (two against CAI in Round One and one against LD Alajuelense in the round of 16) in addition to 10 shots in 4 appearances.

**Esmir Bajraktarevic (USA).** Scored 1 goal, provided 2 assists, and had 5 shots in 4 appearances in the 2024 CCC. The 19-year-old forward has scored 2 goals in his 5 international appearances for the club.

**Henrich Ravas (ESL)**. Is the goalkeeper with the highest number of clean sheets in the 2024 CCC with (3). The Slovakian-born player kept a clean sheet in 75% of the matches with 13 saves and 7 total clearances.

**Giacomo Vrioni (ITA)** Scored his first goal in the CCC and became the fourth Italian player to score a goal in the CCC since 2008-2009, following Daniele Paponi of CF Montreal (CAN) in 2013, Marco di Vaio of CF Montreal (CAN) in 2014, and Sebastian Giovinco of Toronto FC (CAN) in 2018.



Club América eliminated Guadalajara to advance to the guarterfinals.

Club América has an average of 2 goals per game and scored 6 out of 8 goals in the second half of each game.

The 7-time champion of Concacaf Clubs (1977, 1987, 1990, 1992, 2006, 2015, and 2016) will seek to continue with a 100% effectiveness in the quarterfinals of the CCC of the 7 series they have played; Club América advanced in all of them.



The last defeat of Club América in the quarterfinals was (0-1) against Atlanta United, with a goal by Jackson Conway, in 2020. They won 10 out of 14 matches in the quarterfinals (the rest were 2 defeats and 2 draws).

## Players to watch:

**Julián Quiñones (MEX)**. Has scored two goals and provided one assist. He is one of the players with the most shots in Club América in the 2024 CCC with (8). Quiñones has scored 8 goals in 18 appearances in the CCC.

**Jonathan Dos Santos (MEX)**. Leads in passes (234) in Club América in the 2024 CCC. Dos Santos has an 89% pass accuracy in 3 matches. He faced NE Revolution in 2018 and 2019 in the MLS as a player for LA Galaxy.

**Alejandro Zendejas (MEX)**. Scored goals against Real Estelí and Guadalajara in Round One and the round of 16. The forward is the team's leader in shots with (11) in addition to one assist and has received 11 fouls.
