



Frazsiers (JAM) vs. Gotham FC (USA)

Group A, October 2nd, 2024 National Stadium, Kingston.

They will face each other for the first time in an international club tournament.



FRAZSIERS WHIP (JAM)

Frazsiers Whip has lost all three of their matches in their debut tournament at the CWCC 2024-25 (vs. Alajuelense, Monterrey, and Tigres UANL).

The champions of the Jamaican Women's Premier League 2022/23 will play at home for the second time; in the previous match, they scored their first goal against Tigres UANL (Davia Richards).

Coach Courtney Dowdie's (JAM) team made 13 shots in the three Group A matches: one goal scored, with 5 shots on target, 1 hitting the post, and 6 going wide. They achieved 51 ball recoveries, the second-best record among all teams.

Standout players:

Nevillegail Able (JAM). Provided the assist for the goal against Tigres UANL. The team captain has recovered 10 balls in 287 minutes on the pitch.

Davia Richards (JAM). Scored the only goal for Frazsiers vs. Tigres UANL in week 3, in addition to a shot that hit the post against Monterrey (in week 2).

Italya Robinson (JAM). The 16-year-old goalkeeper has made 20 saves in three matches. In the last game against Tigres UANL, she made 10 saves and didn't concede any goals in the first half against Alajuelense.



GOTHAM (USA)

Gotham FC remains undefeated in Group A: defeating Alajuelense 4-0 (Esther González, Katie Stengel, Jenna Nighswonger, and Delanie Sheehan) and drawing 0-0 with CF Monterrey. The 2023 NWSL champions will play their second away game; previously, they won 0-4 in Costa Rica.

The two-time National Women's Soccer League (NWSL) champions kept a clean sheet in their first two matches and limited their opponents to only 7 shots, one hitting the post and six going off target.

Against Alajuelense, they achieved 62% ball possession and 58% (vs. CF Monterrey) with 849 effective passes at a 90% accuracy.

Standout players:

Esther González (ESP). The Spanish FIFA World Cup champion made (6) shots, (scored 1 goal against Alajuelense) and drew the most fouls (4).

Delanie Sheehan (USA). Scored 1 goal against Alajuelense in Gotham FC's only victory. She has played 88 minutes.

McCall Zerboni (USA). The 37-year-old veteran leads the team in passes with (115), 104 of those passes were accurate (90% effectiveness) and she has 3 ball recoveries.
