

Comunicaciones FC (GUA) vs. LD Alajuelense (CRC)

Thursday, September 26, 2024, Estadio Cementos Progreso, Guatemala, GUA

They will face each other for the second time in the same edition of the CCAC.

On August 27, 2024, in Alajuela (CRC), in Group B, Alajuelense won 2-1 with an own goal by Alejandro Prieto and the youth player Santiago van der Putten, while Diego Casas scored from a penalty for Comunicaciones.

In direct elimination matches, they have faced each other 4 times (all in the Concacaf Champions Cup), with LD Alajuelense advancing three times and being eliminated once.

The first time they met in official tournaments was in the second round of the Concacaf Champions Cup 1962 on April 15, 1962, in Guatemala City, where Comunicaciones won 3-1 with goals from Hugo "tin-tan" Peña x2 and Jerónimo Pericullo, and Guido Peña scored for Alajuelense; in the return game in Alajuela on April 29, 1962, the locals won 3-2 with a hat-trick by Guido Peña and for Comunicaciones, Obdulio Pensamiento and Hugo "tin-tan" Peña scored. However, Alajuelense was eliminated with a global score of 5-4.

The last time these clubs faced each other in a direct elimination series was in the quarterfinals of the Concacaf Champions Cup 2002, which was won by Alajuelense with a global score of 6-2.

In the first leg on April 14, 2002, in Guatemala City (GUA), Alajuelense won 3-2 with goals from Érick Jiménez x2 and Sandro Alfaro, and Fredy "topsi" Thompson and Fredy "zurdo" García scored for Comunicaciones. In the return match in Alajuela (CRC) on April 24, 2002, the locals won 3-0, with goals from Pablo Chinchilla, Steven Bryce, and Jozef Miso.

Comunicaciones has won two consecutive home games (1-0 vs. Alianza FC and 2-1 vs. Marathón, at Estadio Cementos Progreso, Guatemala City) and is undefeated in 4 matches (W-2 D-2). Their only defeat in front of their home crowd came against CS Herediano in the closing of the group phase of the 2023 edition.

The 2021 Scotiabank Concacaf League champions lost one of their last 6 matches in the Central American Cup (scoring in each of those matches). In 2023, they were eliminated in the quarterfinals by CS Herediano.

Comunicaciones has not been able to defeat Costa Rican teams in six matches in the CCAC, with 3 draws and 3 losses. They faced CS Herediano three times, and CS Cartaginés and LD Alajuelense once each in 2023.

Players to watch:

Diego Casas (URU). The Uruguayan forward scored two goals in the group stage against Marathón and Herediano and made 11 shots.

José Contreras (GUA). Led in passes with (123) in the group stage. The experienced midfielder has played in 34 international club-level matches, scoring 3 goals and providing 6 assists.

Azarías Londoño (PAN). Scored a goal (against Marathón) and provided an assist against LA Firpo. The Panamanian took 6 shots in 340 minutes played in the CCAC.



Liga Deportiva Alajuelense is undefeated in the Central American Cup over 14 matches (W-11 D-3), having won the inaugural edition in 2023. They are the only club to have scored in every match and are the highest scorers in the CCAC with 35 goals.

The defending champions won all 8 group stage matches (4 in 2023 and 4 in 2024), scoring 11 goals and conceding 6 in the 2024 edition. They secured 3 wins and 3 draws in the knockout stages, scoring 8 goals across their 3 away knockout stage matches (W-2 D-1).

LD Alajuelense had the most points (24), goals (24), victories (7), and passes (4155) in the 2023 edition. They also secured all the available points in the quarterfinals, defeating Cartaginés in the 2023 series (1-3 and 3-0).

Players to watch:

Diego Campos (CRC). Was the top scorer in the group stage with 5 goals against CD Marathón, Luis Ángel Firpo, and a brace against Alianza FC. He took 14 shots in 4 matches.

Aarón Suárez (CRC). Provided four assists, made 7 shots, and scored a goal in the 2024 group stage. The 22-year-old has scored 8 goals and made 4 assists in 28 matches in Concacaf club tournaments.

Celso Borges (CRC). Is the only player from LD Alajuelense to have been on the field for every CCAC match (14). The experienced midfielder led in passes (181) and ball recoveries (6) for the defending champions.
