## Real Hope FA (HAI) vs. Arnett Gardens (JAM)

They will face each other for the second time. They were rivals in the former Caribbean Club Cup 2018, where Arnett Gardens achieved a 4-0 victory with a hat-trick by Fabian Reid and a goal by Leon Strickland in Group A at the Ato Boldon Stadium in Couva on February 4, 2018.



Real Hope FA remains undefeated in Group A in their debut tournament at the Concacaf Caribbean Cup, with a record of 1 win and 1 draw (1-1 vs. Miscellaneous Police FC (Angelo Exilus; Kwesi Allen) and 1-2 vs. Cavalier (Dwayne Atkinson; Rikanel Chery and Steeve Mondestin).

The club, based in the city of Cap-Haïtien, will play its second home game after drawing 1-1 against Police FC.

The Haitian team scored 3 goals in their 2 matches and did not score in the first 30 minutes of play. They conceded 1 goal per game (during the initial and final 5 minutes).

## Players to watch:

**Jeudy Jhonson (HAI)**. The captain provided 1 assist in the 2-1 victory against Cavalier. The 25-year-old midfielder completed 47 accurate passes in his tournament debut, achieving a pass success rate of 94%.

**Huguens Michel (HAI)**. He led the shot (3) and recoveries (3) statistics against Cavalier in the 1-2 victory during Round 3 of Group A. The 30-year-old defender leads the team in shots (5) at Real Hope.

**Steeve Mondestin (HAI)**. He scored the penalty goal that gave Real Hope their first victory in the history of the competition (vs. Cavalier). He made 2 shots and did not miss any of his 6 passes after coming on as a substitute.



## **ARNETT GARDENS (JAM)**

Arnett Gardens Football Club lost their first two matches in their debut tournament at the Concacaf Caribbean Cup: 1-2 vs. MT Pleasant (Shai Smith; Jahshaun Anglin and Kimoni Bailey) at Sabina Park Stadium in Kingston; and 2-1 vs. Arnett Gardens (Joevin Jones and Ezekiel Kesar; Warner Brown), Group A, Hasely Crawford Stadium in Port of Spain.

The 2024 Caribbean Club Shield champions have scored 2 goals in the CCC 2024, both in the second half (Shai Smith vs. Mt. Pleasant and Warner Brown vs. Police FC in Group A).

The winner of 5 titles in the Jamaica Premier League is second among all teams in shots with (33), behind AC Port of Spain, and the Jamaican club has the best average of shots per match (16.5). In the last match, they made 23 shots: 10 on goal, 10 off-target, 1 goal, and 2 hits the posts.

## Players to watch:

**Kimani Arbouine (JAM)**. He provided the assist for Shai Smith's headed goal in his tournament debut (vs. Mt Pleasant). He was the player with the highest number of shots in both matches in the competition (3 vs. Mt. Pleasant and 6 vs. Police FC).

**Warner Brown (JAM)**. Scored the temporary equalizing goal in the 2-1 defeat against Miscellaneous Police FC in Round 3 of the CONCACAF Caribbean Cup 2024. He was second in shots in the last match (4).

**Jamone Shepherd (JAM)**. The midfielder played in the previous 2 matches where he excelled as the top player in total passes (121), accurate passes (110), pass accuracy (91%), and recovered balls (6). He completed 4 shots in the competition.
