



## **Moca FC (DOM) vs. Ouanaminthe (HAI)**

Wednesday, September 18, 2024, Group B, Moca 85 Stadium, Moca

The teams will face each other for the first time in the Caribbean Cup.

### **Week 2: Moca FC (DOM) 3-2 Port of Spain (TRI)**

Moca FC (DOM) extended its unbeaten streak to four matches in the tournament's history (2W-2D), and with this victory, ended a run of two consecutive draws.

Moca FC (DOM) achieved its seventh win in the CCC, ranking it second among Dominican clubs in terms of victories.

Moca FC has secured 6 of the last 7 victories for Dominican clubs in the CCC, with the other win coming from Cibao FC.

Alan Aciar (ARG) of Moca FC scored his second goal in the CCC, his first goal since the 2020 edition (January 31, 2020) against Don Bosco (HAI) in Group A's Matchday 2, while playing for Cibao FC (DOM).

Gustavo Ascona (ARG) of Moca FC scored his fifth goal in the CCC, becoming the team's top scorer in the competition.

Clifford Thomas (HAI) of Moca FC scored his second goal in the CCC history, his only previous goal was on November 28, 2023, against Harbour View (JAM) in the third-place match of the 2023 edition.



### **MOCA FC (DOM)**

Coach Hiram Apaiz's team remains unbeaten in the 2024 CCC: 0-0 vs. Cibao FC and 3-2 vs. AC Port of Spain. Moca FC has gone 4 matches without a defeat (2W, 2D).

Moca FC was the team with the most header goals in the 2023 edition: 3 (Manuel Vidal, Gustavo Ascona, and José Francisco). Of their last 7 goals, 4 have come from set-piece plays (2 headers and 2 penalties).

Moca FC has kept a clean sheet in 50% of their matches in CCC history (5 out of 10). Additionally, they have not lost at home, with 4 wins and 1 draw, and did not concede goals in 3 of their 4 previous victories (1-0 vs. AC Port of Spain, 3-0 vs. Golden Lion, and 1-0 vs. Robinhood).

**Participations in the CCC:** 2 (2023 and 2024).

**Best result in the CCC:** 3rd place (2023).

**Record in the CCC:** 10 games, 6 wins, 2 draws, 2 losses (GF-13, GA-8).

**Top scorers in the CCC:** Gustavo Ascona (ARG) 5, Víctor Sánchez (DOM) 2, Manuel Vidal (DOM) 1, Ronaldo De La Peña (DOM), José Francisco (DOM), Sebastián Valencia (COL), Clifford Thomas (HAI), Alan Aciar (ARG).

Saves in the CCC: Miguel Báez (DOM) 32 (7 in the current edition).

Goal-scoring opportunities (20). Shots on goal (8).

#### **Players to watch:**

**Gustavo Ascona (ARG).** He is the club's top scorer in the CCC with 5 goals in 10 appearances. He scored 3 goals from play, 1 from a penalty, and 1 header. He leads in shots (6) in the 2024 edition.

**Clifford Thomas (HAI).** He scored the goal with which Moca FC defeated AC Port of Spain 3-2. He is the player with the most ball recoveries (7).

**Víctor Sánchez (DOM).** The forward scored a brace against Golden Lion in the 2023 group stage and provided 1 assist (vs. AC Port of Spain in 2024) in his 9 appearances for Moca FC in the CCC.



#### **OUANAMINTHE (HAI)**

Ouanaminthe FC drew 1-1 against AC Port of Spain (Joseph Willinx; Shackiel Smek Henry) in their debut at Estadio Moca 85.

In their first match in the CCC, they managed 50% possession of the ball (completing 77% of their passes: 290 were successful).

**Sinor Louibenn (HAI).** The midfielder led in shots in the first match with 4 (50% on target).

**Roobens Philogene (HAI).** The 28-year-old forward made the most passes with 37.

**Joseph Willinx (HAI).** Scored the only goal vs. AC Port of Spain in the Group B debut). Achieve 86% passing accuracy in the debut.
