Players to Watch:

Cuba (CUB)

David Perez. Scored a hat trick, provided an assist, and had the most shots on goal on the first day of the qualifiers.

Marcos Campos. Scored a hat-trick with just 4 shots in the 13-0 victory against Anguilla.

Michael Camejo. Scored 1 goal and was the second player with the most shots on goal on the first day of the qualifiers.

Maikol Vega. Scored a brace in the victory against Anguilla. He had 4 shots after coming on as a substitute.

Anguilla (AIA)

Micah Brooks. Made 8 saves and 2 clearances in Anguilla's debut against Cuba.

Alexander Fleming. The captain of Anguilla made 4 clearances and committed no fouls.

Timarqus Connor. Had 1 shot on goal at the start of the qualifiers.

Nicholson Millington. Was the leader in clearances in Anguilla's first match of the qualifiers.

Nicaragua (NCA)

Francis Castillo. He scored two goals and was the player with the most shots (7) in the Round 1 match against the British Virgin Islands.

Andrés Martínez. Celebrated a brace after coming on as a substitute at the beginning of the second half and completed 5 shots in 45 minutes.

Joab Gutiérrez. Opened the scoring with a header in the 5th minute in the debut of the 2024 Concacaf Under-20 Championship Qualifiers.

Huberts Ibarra. Did not concede goals against the British Virgin Islands, making 4 saves and 4 clearances.

British Virgin Islands (VGB)

Oluwafikayomi Adeniji. Had one shot on goal in the opening match against Nicaragua.

Momchil Yordanov. Made 1 shot on target in the first game of the qualifiers.

Harry Foden. Made 7 saves and completed 14 out of 16 clearances for the British Virgin Islands against Nicaragua.

Jaden Abrams. The team captain played the full 90 minutes in the debut match of the British Virgin Islands in the Qualifiers.



El Salvador (SLV)

Walter Menjivar. The captain contributed 1 goal and provided 1 assist in the victory against Turks and Caicos in the opening match of the CONCACAF qualifying tournament.

Daniel España. He was one of the standout performers for El Salvador in the qualifiers debut with 1 goal, 2 shots, and 3 clearances to protect his goal.

Wilber Diaz. Came on as a substitute in the second half and scored 2 goals in the debut of the Salvadoran national team in the qualifiers.

Nelson Diaz. Scored the final goal for El Salvador in the 7-0 victory against Turks and Caicos and provided 2 assists. He was the Salvadoran player with the most shots on target (2).



Turks and Caicos (TCA)

Peterson Saint Fleurant. Stood out for the Turks and Caicos team with 6 saves and 1 clearance in the opening game of the qualifiers.

Davaughn Daniel. Was the player with the most shots against El Salvador (1 on target and 1 off target).

Emmanuel Martin. Made 1 shot in the debut of his national team in the first match of the 2024 CONCACAF Under-20 Championship Qualifiers.

Kristen Howell. Played the full 90 minutes against El Salvador and completed 4 out of 18 clearances for her team.



Antigua and Barbuda (ATG)

Javauhn Parker. Opened the scoring 88 seconds into the match in the 4-0 victory against Guyana on the opening day of Group B.

Christopher Douglas. Contributed his share of goals against Guyana in the debut and was the player with the most shots (5) in the match.

Aiden Jarvis. The captain of Antigua and Barbuda scored 1 goal with his first shot on target in the CONCACAF qualifying tournament.

Taj Moore. Kept a clean sheet with 7 saves. Made 13 out of the team's 14 clearances in the debut.



Guyana (GUY)

Salomon Austin. The captain led the shot tally in the match against Antigua and Barbuda (4). 75% of his shots were on target.

Nathaniel Pydana. Registered 3 shots in Guyana's debut in the CONCACAF qualifying tournament (1 on target and 2 off target).

Kyle Reid. Made 2 shots on target in Guyana's first match in Group B - 2024 CONCACAF Under-20 Championship Qualifiers.

Emmanuel Lewis. Recorded 2 saves and 5 clearances in the setback against Antigua and Barbuda at the beginning of the CONCACAF Under-20 Championship Qualifiers.

Curacao (CUW)

Daminthly Bernardina. Was the scorer of the only goal against Saint Martin in Curacao's debut in the CONCACAF Under-20 Championship Qualifiers.

Leandro Merencia. Maintained a clean sheet against Saint Martin with 1 save and 3 clearances.

Giordinelo Meulens. Contributed 2 shots in Curacao's debut (1 on target and 1 off target).

Jillian Bernardina. Completed 2 shots in the opening match of the CONCACAF qualifying tournament.

Saint Martin (SNM)

Sacha Barakat. Took 1 shot in Saint Martin's first match in Group C of the CONCACAF Under-20 Championship Qualifiers.

Mathieu Carty. Led the shots category (2) against Curacao in the opening match.

Roman Magloire. Contributed with 2 saves and 12 clearances in the defeat of the first match of the qualifying tournament.

Andre Richardson. Wore the captain's armband in Saint Martin's debut in the 2024 CONCACAF Championship Qualifiers.

Guatemala (GUA)

Héctor Prillwitz. The defender scored Guatemala's first goal in the 3-0 victory against Barbados in the CONCACAF Under-20 Championship Qualifiers.

Olger Escobar. Contributed with a goal and was one of the Guatemalan players with the most shots in the opening match (4).

Diego Bolaños. Conceded 1 goal and made 3 saves in Guatemala's debut in the qualifying tournament. Did not concede any goals in the second 45 minutes of play.

Marvin Avila. Led the shots category (4) in the Guatemala national team alongside Olger Escobar and Matthew Evans.



Barbados (BRB)

Rovaldo Massiah. Scored the temporary equalizer in the 3-1 defeat against Guatemala and was the player who made the most shots for his team (2).

K Den Hee Chung. Was one of the goalkeepers with the best save record on the opening day (12). Made 7 clearances against Guatemala.

Ethan Taylor. The captain of Barbados contributed with 1 shot in the debut in the qualifying tournament.

Khalil Vanderpool-Nurse. Made 1 shot on target in the match against Guatemala.



Canada (CAN)

Myles Morgan. Scored a hat-trick in the 8-0 victory against Dominica at the beginning of the CONCACAF qualifying tournament. Contributed with 6 shots in the 90 minutes of play.

Santiago López. Celebrated a brace and led the overall shots category in the opening match against Dominica (7).

Sergei Kozlovskiy. Scored a double and made 3 shots against the Dominica National Team in just 17 minutes played during Matchday 1.

Jesse Costa. The captain provided 2 assists and had 2 shots (1 on target and 1 off target) in Canada's debut in the 2024 CONCACAF Under-20 Championship Qualifiers.



Dominica (DMA)

Ronny Lockhart. Made 10 saves and 1 clearance in Dominica's first match in the CONCACAF Under-20 Championship Qualifiers.

Lyan Edwards. Was the player with the highest clearance count against Canada in the opening day of the qualifying tournament.

Dequan Abraham. Was the Dominica player who received the most fouls in the Matchday 1 duel against Canada (2).

Malachi Labad. Tallied 3 clearances in the team's first match in the current competition.



Trinidad (TRI)

Larry Noel. Contributed with a goal in the 3-2 victory against Saint Vincent and was the player with the most shots (7).

Michael Chaves. Entered the game at the end of the first half and was instrumental in Trinidad's victory on the opening day with 1 goal from 3 shots.

Cody Cooper. The captain opened the scoring in Trinidad's group stage debut in the qualifying tournament and committed no fouls.

Josiah Ochoa. Had a direct involvement in 1 of the 3 goals against Saint Vincent with 1 assist.

Saint Vincent (VIN)

Kirtney Franklyn. The captain converted the first goal for the team from a penalty in the defeat against Trinidad.

Tristan John. Contributed with 8 saves and provided 1 clearance in Saint Vincent's first match in Group D of the Concacaf qualifying tournament.

Steven Pierre. Was one of the goal scorers for Saint Vincent in the debut of the 2024 CONCACAF Under-20 Championship Qualifiers against Trinidad.

Frankroy Cain. Provided an assist to Steven Pierre's header in the first half of the match against Trinidad on Matchday 1.

Haiti (HAI)

Bryan Destin. Scored a hat-trick (field goal, header, and penalty) and made 5 out of 15 shots in the 4-1 victory against the Cayman Islands after coming on in the 55th minute of the game.

Schneilorens Lebrun. Scored the first goal for Haiti with a header in the opening match of Group E in the CONCACAF qualifying tournament.

Louis Isaie. Made 3 shots and scored 1 goal in his debut in the qualifying tournament for the 2024 CONCACAF Under-20 Championship.

Rikanel Chery. The defender contributed with 1 shot, 2 corner kicks, and 1 assist in Haiti's debut.

Puerto Rico (PUR)

Daniel Cruz. Scored 1 of the 5 goals in the victory against Saint Kitts in the opening match of the CONCACAF qualifying tournament. Led the shots category with 6.

Sebastian Otero. Contributed 1 goal in Puerto Rico's first match and had 5 goal-scoring opportunities in the game (1 goal, 3 shots on target, and 1 off target).

Cristian Ortiz. Provided two assists in Puerto Rico's debut in the CONCACAF Under-20 Championship Qualifiers for the 2024 tournament.

Adrian Biaggi. The captain opened the scoring in the 4th minute of the match and had 2 shots in the 90 minutes of play.



Cayman Islands (CAY)

Joshua Campbell. Was the scorer of the only goal for the Cayman Islands in the debut of the group stage of the 2024 CONCACAF Under-20 Championship Qualifying.

Immanuel Duran. Had a direct influence on the goal against Haiti with his assist and was the player with the highest number of shots (2).

Lachlin Lambert. Made 3 saves and added 1 clearance in the opening match against the Haiti National Team.

Kane Watson. Topped the clearance ranking (11) in the first match of the Cayman Islands in the qualifying tournament for the 2024 CONCACAF Under-20 Championship.



Saint Kitts and Nevis (SKN)

Kai Francois. Set a record for saves (13) on the first day of qualifiers. Added 4 clearances in Saint Kitts and Nevis' debut in the tournament.

Caaja Burnham. Was one of the players from the Saint Kitts and Nevis team who had the opportunity to score the first goal of the match (1 shot).

Devion Harvey. Was the player with the most clearances against Puerto Rico (5).

De Quan Hamilton. The forward made 1 shot and took 2 corner kicks in the team's opening match.
